THE INTENT, AGE OR EXCEPTIONALITY OF A STUDENT, OR A HAZARD ONLY/NEAR MISS DOES NOT IMPACT THE REQUIREMENT TO REPORT.

EMPLOYEE INCIDENT
REPORTING AND
INVESTIGATION FORM (EIRIF)
ON VIOLENCE

SAFE SCHOOLS INCIDENT REPORTING FORM (SSIR)

**Workplace Violence** as defined by the OHSA:

 the exercise of physical force or an attempt at physical force that causes or could cause injury to a worker

#### **OR**

 a statement or behaviour that is reasonable for a worker to interpret as a threat to use physical force that could cause injury to a worker

#### Part One - EIRIF

- Complete the form on eBase when there has been injury to a worker, or the potential for injury has occurred
- the form will be submitted to your immediate supervisor through eBase

# Part Two – EIRIF Administrator Response

- Will be emailed to the worker within 24 hours, and should include a link to the investigation
- The response will include measures to prevent recurrence

# Part Three – EIRIF Worker Response

 If worker feels their safety is still at risk and has not been resolved at the site level, please contact the Local. SCAN HERE for activities where

suspension or expulsion must be considered are at the top of EIRIF and SSIR forms



#### Part One - SSIR

- Complete the form on eBase when there has been an incident involving student behaviour by a student or between students
- The form will be submitted to your immediate supervisor through eBase

### Part Two – SSIR Administrator Response

- Will be emailed to the worker within 72 hours indicating Action Taken or No Action Required
- Action Taken references if suspension or expulsion occurred, not if an investigation occurred or if measures were put in place

### EMPLOYEE INCIDENT REPORTING AND INVESTIGATION FORM (EIRIF)

All other health and safety

Report a potential or existing hazard to your supervisor which you believe presents a risk to the health or safety of individuals in your workplace – this fulfills the Internal Responsibility System for reporting hazards in your workplace – you may involve your site health and safety representative for support.
